

## NORFOLK FAMILY WALK 2020

We are writing to inform you that that the 2020 Norfolk Family Walk for Brain Tumours will take place at Holkham Hall, near Wells-next-the-Sea, North Norfolk, on Sunday 4th October from 10am to 4pm. The walk is in its fourteenth year and we welcome walkers of all calibre – gentle strollers or families who enjoy the one mile amble or three mile beautiful walk around the lake to the super fit who manage the ten miles, mostly with a pit stop at Wells-next-the-Sea to refuel on fish & chips or even a pint!

Last year, over 200 people plus lots of four legged friends took part in the walk and in excess of £11,500 was raised, in spite of the wettest weather we have ever experienced! Some walkers were sponsored and others made generous donations and we'd like to say a grateful thanks to everybody who came and helped us raise this impressive amount.

We're hoping that this year yet more walkers will get sponsored for their efforts so we can raise even more money for vital brain tumour research.
